Bowlers entered on squads $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}, \mathrm{C}$ can use their handicap qualifying score to qualify for shootout. The number of finalists is determined by total entries.

All participants will be entered in a drawing for a chance to win STORM bowling balls.

1. This is a tournament open to both men and women.
2. All USBC rules will govern this tournament.
3. AVERAGES: All bowlers will use their highest USBC sanctioned averages from the 20-21, 21-22, 22-23 seasons, with a minimum of 30 games. Anyone without a 21-22, 22-23, 23-24 ( 30 games) average must enter at the maximum average. Sport Shot or Tough Shot league averages must be reported at check-in. Summer league, collegiate, and YABA averages will not be accepted, but are required to be reported prior to bowling. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction at the time of bowling may disqualify any score. Any bowler with an average 10 or more pins higher than any average from the past 10 seasons must report this at time of check-in for possible adjustment. Prize winnings may be based on the average submitted to the tournament if it is higher than the correct average. Unsanctioned averages for the past three seasons must also be reported prior to bowling. First year bowlers must have 45 games ( $22-23$ season) to qualify for handicap.

## 4. MAXIMUM AVERAGE FOR HANDICAP IS 215.

5. A bowler who has bowled 100 pins or more over his/her average in a 3 game tournament event ( 133 pins for 4 games, 166 pins for 5 games) in the 24 months prior to the time of bowling is required to report said scores prior to registration even though the prizes for the said score(s) have not been awarded. The bowler may then be subject to average adjustment. Failure to report said score(s) could result in disqualification. (Includes both sanctioned
and unsanctioned events.)
6. AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT: All entrants are required to be familiar with the USBC rule regarding rerating requirements and comply with all requirements. This tournament has the right to rerate, reject or reclassify any entry without penalty prior to the time of actual participation.
7. Any bowler that has been rerated by any tournament (sanctioned, unsanctioned, or TV show) must report this before bowling and is subject to rerate or denial of entry based on his/ her report. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
8. Any bowler occupying a Top 10 position in any tournament/ event (sanctioned or unsanctioned) must report this at the time of registration. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
9. Entry fee will be refunded if entrant(s) do not wish to participate after being notified of any rerating.
10. Any bowler who reports a lower average than required or who fails to report a prize winning of $\$ 200$ or more in a sanctioned and/or unsanctioned event from the past 24 months, prior to bowling each separate event may forfeit all tournament fees and winnings. All declarations of winnings must be in writing, in ink, signed and dated by the declaring bowler.

11. Handicap $80 \%$ of 215 . Maximum handicap is 72 pins per game.
12. Check in begins one (1) hour prior to each squad. Prepaid entries must be checked in 20 minutes before scheduled squad time or your spot may be sold.
13. Lanes will be assigned at time of check in.
14. Squad confirmed unless otherwise notified.
15. Anyone qualifying for the finals (top 96) and is unable to participate in the finals will be paid for 73rd thru 96th. Substitutions will not be allowed.
16. This is a multiple entry tournament. You may cash more than once, but only once in the top 96.
17. TIES: A one game roll off will determine a tie for 96 th. A tie for a bye spot is broken by high game. Anyone qualifying for more than 1 bye will use his or her first score. A tie in the top 96 will be broken by high qualifying game. A 9th \& 10th frame roll off will determine a tie in the finals.
18. Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel due to inclement weather, strikes, disaster, act of God, etc.
19. A withdrawal form must be filled out and submitted to the tournament office at least 20 minutes prior to a squad's scheduled start time to receive a refund. All refunds will be charged a $\$ 5.00$ administrative fee. The refund amount will be $\$ 55.00$.
20. Anyone who has won a PBA National event in the past 10 years is not eligible.
21. All bowlers must be at least 18 years of age at the time of competition.
22. Dress Code: All finalists must wear long pants and approved shirt. Dress jeans are acceptable. No tee shirts, hats or tank tops.
23. Tournament Committee has final say in any disputes.
24. Pay off immediately following tournament pending average verification.
25. Prize ratio approximately 1:5.
26.1 in 5 bowlers off each squad will cash for $\$ 60.00$. Instant cash will be paid immediately following each squad pending average and score verification. Instant cash will be deducted from all finalists' prize money.

Finals Format: 96 Finalists bowl single game elimination matches until final 3 remain. Seeding for the finals will be determined by qualifying score.


All bowlers on week squads will be entered in a Storm Bowling Ball Drawing for each squad. Bowlers will receive additional entries for the drawing for every 200+ game bowled with handicap. Drawing following each squad.
